Aim:	To provide coaches with the ability to prepare riders for competitions. Emphasizing skill, develop participation and enjoyment
Duration of the course:	5 days
Entry Requirements for Participants:	18 years old and over - Have a knowledge of horses and horsemanship (responsibility of the NF) - Have completed an FEI Introduction to Coaching course - Have a First Aid Safety certificate (recommendation)
Attendance:	14 participants + 10 observers (max)

Level:	- Jumping: 1.00 - 1.15 m - Dressage: Elementary/Medium - Eventing: Novice up to 1*
Insurance:	Participants must be registered with their NF coach insurance scheme or privately
