<b>Entry Requirements for Participants:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 18 years old and over</li><li>• Have a knowledge of horses and horsemanship (responsibility of the NF)</li><li>• Have completed or are presently attending a NAT Coaching course</li><li>• Have a First Aid Safety certificate (recommendation)</li></ul>
